USAGE:

Lay carpet into adhesive that is still wet enough to ensure 100% transfer to the carpet backing, and roll with a 75–100 lbs. roller. When installing over a non-porous surface, let adhesive become tacky.

TRAFFIC:

Follow the flooring manufacturer's installation guidelines; otherwise restrict foot traffic for 24 hours after installation. No heavy traffic, rolling loads, or furniture placement for 72 hours after installation. Additional time may be necessary if the installation is over a non-porous substrate. Allow at least five days following the installation before conducting wet cleaning procedures or initial maintenance.

OPEN TIME:

20-40 minutes, depending on substrate, ambient temperature and humidity.

CLEAN UP:

Use a clean wet cloth to clean up adhesive while still wet. Dried adhesive may require the use of an appropriate solvent.
